

In my view, the USO should provide a universal right to receive a minimum speed of at least 10Mbps for all UK citizens. Except in the rarest of situations, this service should be accompanied by a low latency, i.e. should not rely on satellite reception.

I did not say that the above should be a free provision. It makes sense to:

1. Furnish the service only where it is requested.
2. Require a capped contribution to the reasonable installation cost.
