Any USO regulation seems to be yet another political diversion so wastes valuable Public Servant resources.

The whole of the UK requires true symmetric Point-to-Point FTTH just as B4RN.org.uk are achieving in rural Lancashire, South Cumbria and North Yorkshire now followed by Gigaclear's announcement for East Devon (plus probably all CDS phase Two areas). Once symmetric FTTH is available any requirement for a USO evaporates immediately. Why not divert ALL attention to achieving symmetric FTTH? (and disregard BT's limited asymmetric offerings too)
