

Adequate broadband is vital for rural communities such as Drinkstone. While the USO is welcome and necessary, we believe it should rise in line with average speeds, as usage of broadband will inevitably rise, and 10mbps is only just adequate today.

Measures should also be in place to ensure that Openrach actually delivers the minimum speed set by the USO. At present, provided you receive more than 4mbps, they don't seem to care if you cannot achieve anything better.
