As one who has been working for decent broadband for my community for six years and who finds after all this time the best BT Openreach can provide in DT7 3RD is 0.7 mbps download and 0.2mbps upload. And this is after receiving a massive subsidy from the taxpayer. We are told that there are no plans to improve our almost non existent broadband. We are within a few hundred yards of a cabinet that will be fibred shortly but BT Openreach refuse to connect us to that cabinet even at our expense.

BT Openreach through their refusal to provide a decent broadband service in this part of Rousdon, prevents all other ISPs supplying their customers. Their monopoly position in rural areas is totally unacceptable therefore I strongly support the proposal to separate BT Openreach from BT with an obligation to provide a universal broadband service of a minimum speed of 24mbps.
