Question 1:Do you agree with the proposal to include, as a matter of course, the 470 kHz and 5 MHz bands into the Licence for all Amateur Radio (Full) licensees?:

No, only on the same basis as all other bands with no change of conditions and deleting 'electronic equipment' as this is too wide ranging and not radio related (if it is not radio equipment it should be immune to RF or should not pass any type approvals)

Question 2:Do you agree that expressly linking a Full (Club) Licensee?s authorisation to use the spectrum to his or her representation of a named club, and by adding a further ground for revoking the Licence to include circumstances where the licensee no longer represents the club, will help ensure that a club?s call sign remains with the club?:

yes, possibly being issued to a club committee officer (secretary, chairman or station manager) avoiding sole control of the callsign by an individual

No. The secondary country identifier shows the location of the station which is important to users, not the home address of the licensee, which would cause utter confusion worldwide

Question 8:Do you agree with Ofcom?s proposal to amend Clause 2(3) of the Licence to require Intermediate licensees to transmit a call sign that reflects the location of their main station?:

No - should be the same for all classes of licence, the RSL used should reflect the location of the station as the time, not the home address of the licensee
