**Question 1:Do you agree with the proposal to include, as a matter of course, the 470 kHz and 5 MHz bands into the Licence for all Amateur Radio (Full) licensees?:**

No.

We cannot be expected to avoid interfering with poorly designed non-radio "other...electronic equipment". Also, we would like to claim protection from such equipment. Although these terms are proposed for these two bands only, I worry that the clauses will spread to our other bands in time.

**Question 2:Do you agree that expressly linking a Full (Club) Licensee's authorisation to use the spectrum to his or her representation of a named club, and by adding a further ground for revoking the Licence to include circumstances where the licensee no longer represents the club, will help ensure that a club's call sign remains with the club?:**

**Question 8:Do you agree with Ofcom?s proposal to amend Clause 2(3) of the Licence to require Intermediate licensees to transmit a call sign that reflects the location of their main station?:**

No.

There is some confusion with the intermediate licence, but this does not solve it.

I think the callsign used on-air should reflect the current location, not reflect the main address.

I think the idea of issuing a "core" callsign is good.

You also need to change your guidance booklet and on-screen advice. When I last used them, the advice given was that users could choose a preferred callsign of the format '2E...', but, when we tried, none of the preferred callsigns was "available". In fact, the licence issued was in the format "20...". If you could change your advice to match what will really happen, that would be good.

**Question 9:Do you agree that replacing Clauses 2(1) and 16(1) with a new Clause to simplify and bring together all of the licence conditions relating to the operation of radio equipment away from the Main Station address will make these provisions clearer?:**
