Question 1:Do you agree with the proposal to include, as a matter of course, the 470 kHz and 5 MHz bands into the Licence for all Amateur Radio (Full) licensees?:

We have secondary access to other bands and the license is perfectly adequate in its terms with regards to these , Access to 470 khz and 5 mhz should by full license holders with the same secondary conditions.

Paragraph 2.26.3 should be amended so that electronic equipment which is not radio related should not be included as it is presently not investigated by ofcom in relation to interference which it may be experiencing.

As far as Paragraph 2.26.6 is concerned a common sense approach should be encouraged as near field rf at 470Khz is difficult to measure
