Question 3.1: Do you agree that the modification to the Numbering Plan that we propose – which would prohibit direct or indirect revenue-sharing with callers and/or end-users by those who use 03 numbers – is appropriate and proportionate to address the conduct of concern that we have described in this document? I do not believe the response is either appropriate or proportional. As a foreigner living in the UK, I use my mobile most of the time and do not have a landline at home. I'm aware that if I was to ring my home country through my mobile (Europe – fixed) the rate would be close to £1 per minute, whilst by using the 03 mechanism, the price is much closer to the real international price offered by calling cards.

I pay a hefty monthly rental for my line. I think I should enjoy some flexibility on what numbers I ring. At the end of the day, I choose the tariff based on the inclusive minutes it gives me.
