We can cite numerous examples of exclusive quality journalism - we broke the Uber story and were the only broadcasters at the Shoreham Air show to quote just two. We have started the only LGBT+ channel in Europe, and have won a major Diversity award. We were the only broadcasters at Trans Pride.

We have a major sponsor, Brighton Palace Pier, most of the major companies in Brighton supporting us and a start up TV Academy, with students already having progressed to work at BBC, ITV and Al Jazeera plus other digital companies.

Our business is just turning the corner to profit and positive cash flow after our early investment. Your consideration of moving the epg position puts all of that at risk and is clearly unfair. This amounts to £100k to £200k of our earnings at real risk. This cannot be justified - the status quo should remain, given all the business plans were based on this understanding.

We trust that appropriate consideration will be given to this and the status quo will prevail.
