Question	Your response
Consultation question 1: Do you have any comments on our proposed approach to compliance monitoring?	Is this response confidential? —N The collaborative approach is welcome, as well as using the tiering system to gauge this. However, the elephant in the room for all tier 2&3 vendors is the (yet to be clarified) indications that if a lower tier vendor supplies services to a higher tier vendor they will be expected to operate at that high tier level. If this is the case the financial, operational and timings placed on smaller vendors would be untenable. For example the organisation I am responding for would be Tier3 based on turnover, but we provide services via a wholesale agreement, to a Tier1 vendor.
Consultation question 2: Do you have any comments on our proposed approach to testing?	This needs urgent clarification. It seems quite straight forward, but again, if a tier 3 organisation is pulled up into Tier 2 or 1, then they may not have the organisation competencies to run a full TBEST exercise.
Consultation question 3: Do you have any comments on our proposed approach to enforcement?	No comments
Consultation question 4: Do you have any comments on our proposed approach to reporting security compromises?	This section seems to presuppose that a provider is supplying services to end users. Advice to wholesale AltNets would be useful here, where the network provider, delivers a transport layer service to a CP who then delivers end customer services via this route.
