<p>Question 1: Do you have any comments on our drafting of the Proposed Regulations? Please give reasons supported by evidence for your views.</p>	<p>Confidential? – N</p> <p>Ofcom’s Statement of October 2025 (para. 4.22) stated,</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">We agree with Shure UK Ltd that the exemption for Audio PMSE should be referenced as 1785–1805 MHz as set out in Recommendation 70-03 and we will make this update accordingly.</p> <p>[see also para. 2.15 of Ofcom’s ‘Notice of proposed regulations’ of 11th December 2025, on alignment with ERC Recommendation 70-03]</p> <p>However, the Draft Updated IR 2030 for LE SRDs of 11th December was not updated to reflect the above and still shows the band’s upper bound as 1804.8 MHz (p.104, IR2030/35/3), not 1805 MHz.</p> <p>The band is 1785-1805 MHz in ERC Recommendation 70-03 (Annex 10, band j).</p> <p>Given Ofcom’s stated intention to correct the Draft, we assume this was a simple oversight but reiterate our previous comment that alignment with 70-03 is desirable to avoid unnecessary conflict in authorisation approaches.</p>
