Ramadan Radio allows integration and during this 30 days provides an open door policy for all in the community then Radio Fever has through the year.

I feel this one license is beneficial as it stands for a specific purpose and most listeners look forward to this radio station broadcasting as it signifies the start of something- the start of Ramadan.

I feel it would be impractical to allow a 'community' radio station that specifies and should adhere to meet the needs of the whole community to be allowed to change their conditions to meet the needs of a minority.

A community radio should be impartial and meet the needs of all. By allowing the conditions to be changed will only set precedence for others to want to do the same in the future. Some changes should not happen for the greater good and I urge you to consider that this is one of them.
