

talkSPORT household coverage figures

In response to requests, analysis has been carried out by Ofcom to determine the impact of the switch off on UK households. The totals shown here present minor variations to those published in the consultation document as these are Ofcom's estimates rather than talkSPORT's.

The first column shows the estimated number of households that would no longer be covered by talkSPORT's AM signal but which could continue to access talkSPORT on a DAB radio. The second column shows the estimated number of households that would no longer be covered by talkSPORT's AM signal and which are not currently able to receive talkSPORT if they own a DAB radio.
