Confidential? – N The consultation centres on the possible impact of the transmitter change on the SSDAB licensed areas of Tynemouth & South Shields and Alnwick & Morpeth. However, the respondent notes that significant areas of coverage gain from the proposed variation of the licensed area impinge into the coverage of local licensed multiplex area, namely Tyne & Wear.
