**Additional comments:**

We would like Ofcom to consider the use of a single 600MHz channel to assist the local television area of Sheffield. Coverage of Sheffield from the local Sheffield transmitter is very limited and there is no other available frequency from Emley Moor at this time. Comux would like to register interest in use of a 600MHz channel as a temporary solution to improve television coverage of the Sheffield area. Comux would work to establish a longer term solution to the coverage area, possibly by the use of a new, more local, transmitter site, but this will take two or three years to investigate and implement.
