

This act should be completely scrapped.

100% of the cost of this should be borne by copyright holders.

It must never apply to any Wi Fi or other shared connections or be based on evidence only of an IP address.

The code should not apply to small ISPs.

Any notifications to subscribers must indicate ALL information regarding the allegations against them. No other information kept hidden at this stage should be admissible during a later appeal.

It is outrageous that an appeal requires £20 up front. This is equivalent to an assumption of guilt until proven innocent. This wouldn't happen in a civilised country and is the sort of thing that would make the UK look like a banana republic

An appeal should be successful if the copyright holder fails to prove beyond reasonable doubt that copyright infringement took place.

Any subscriber who makes a successful appeal should automatically receive at least £10,000 compensation in addition to any expenses incurred.

Subscribers should be able to appeal within 1 year of a notification.
