Consultation question:

Should regional radio station Capital FM (Birmingham) be permitted to make the changes to its Character of Service as proposed with particular regard to the statutory criteria as set out in the summary? (The Broadcasting Act 1990 Section 106 (1A) (b) and (d) relating to Format changes).

The format should not be changed as it could make other local stations which provide a similar format suffer as they already offer the service which is being requested

The original 102.2 station was set up to provide a alternative to chart music stations which has been lost with now a single show on Saturday early mornings primarily for listeners of African or Afro-Caribbean.
