No, I think that it would be just the same as now for Exeter and Torbay, whilst North Devon would just be ignored as if we weren't here at all.

Question 3: Do you think that Now Digital?s proposals for providing coverage of North Devon are satisfactory? Please explain the reasons for your view.:

No, we are a long way from Exeter area up here in North Devon, and experience from losing our local Lantern Radio broadcast from up in Barnstaple to a Heart programme broadcast from Exeter has show us how little relevance the North of this county has to the Exeter area by how little coverage of anything we get.

Would you expect a licence based in Manchester to cover Leeds, Sheffield, Liverpool and Bradford as well? As they are all closer than we are in Barnstaple to Exeter.

There are over 100000 people in the local area, and a local radio ran well, providing local coverage of news, weather and traffic (amongst other things) which was relevant to us. We don't get that anymore, and this would just make it worse.

And this is before the consideration that almost a third of North Devon cannot receive a digital radio signal of even sub-standard quality. It will become a radio silence black hole for a lot of people.

Local dj's care about local interests, charities and people as they're part of our community. Why do we have to be forced to have what isn't right for our small towns, just because some money making scheme decides it, just because it's, supposedly, technologically better.

Better coverage does not make it right. It makes it intrusive and I don't want it!

It is bad enough we lose our local station, to be replaced by Heart Exeter (which provides extremely little information about anything happening up here) but a digital licence would

kill it completely and lose any chance of our hope of a local service again.

I will also re-iterate that almost a third of North Devon cannot receive a digital radio signal of even sub-standard quality. It will become a radio silence black hole for a lot of people. Ofcom should say no. And then allow us to have a licence for a local station, for local people, that we care about.
