- · If that happens, all the FM radio's you currently have in your home and your car will become obsolete and to hear the services you presently listen to on your present radio once those services are switched off, you will HAVE to replace them with DAB radio's.
- · The proposal would initially provide coverage of only 53% of North Devon households, with a proposed coverage of only 70% of households in future years.
- · This means that using their figures, once the FM transmitters are switched off, 30% of those who currently listen to local commercial radio AND BBC Radio Devon in North Devon will no longer be able to receive a signal.
- · North Devon and Torridge will be denied the opportunity to re-establish a genuinely local FM radio service for this community in the future because the present local FM licence would not be re-advertised
