I am commenting purely in my capacity as a citizen/consumer, as I expect responses on the draft plan 2011/12 from members of the general public will be in the minority.

My major concern is that the public spending challenge will impact on Ofcom's ability to defend the rights of the consumer, particularly given the increased future roles it may have (notably the Postal Services Bill and the Digital Economy Act).

I support the streamlining of broadcasting standards procedures. There seems to be a disproportionate amount of resource spent in relation to adult channel breaches on cable channels.

In relation to copyright infringement, a balance between the rights of consumers who have purchased material legitimately and subsequently wish to use it across domestic digital media and the rights of industry would be welcome.

Finally, it would be helpful if future consultations could include specific questions relating to topics that Ofcom would like to seek specific public feedback on.
