## Question 2: Do consultees have any further suggestions for future access service provision? If so please provide the rationale for these suggestions:

Increase the audio description provision to all programmes. Its not difficult to do. And not that expensive. Some programmes will require more description than others - documentaries/interviews/ quiz shows may require less input than dramas or films.
