A 'frequency so given up' cannot be passed on to another user but must be returned to the European pool for reallocation as it is managed by the World Radio Conference, therefore a vital aviation infrastructure would therefore be lost with an increased risk to life and property without any increase in value from spectrum, contrary to the aims of AIP.

I would be grateful for details of the strategic management role that you propose government undertakes for these systems together with a very clear reason that the present arrangements are inadequate.
