**Samsung Electronics UK (SEUK) response to UK Ofcom on Freedom4  
application for licence variation:**

**7th July 2009**

**Consultation Question:**

*Are there any reasonable grounds why Ofcom should not grant Freedom4's request to vary its licence as soon as practicable? If so, please explain your reasoning for this?*

Having reviewed the analysis detailed in the consultation document, SEUK believes that Freedom4 have carefully and rigorously considered the impact of their proposals on the other users of the spectrum and shown this to be minimal.

Therefore SEUK agrees that the case has been made to vary the terms of Freedom4's licence in the UK as soon as practicable.

Generally SEUK has supported the European developments that have resulted in a regulatory framework enabling mobile terminal devices in the 3.5GHz frequency ranges. SEUK applauds these steps to align the UK operator licences with these developments.
