Dear Mr Richards,

I write to you regarding UTV Radio's proposals to co-locate Valleys Radio, Swansea Sound and The Wave in a single South Wales Headquarters such as the one being proposed at Swansea Gate Business Park.

I wish to support their bid. I understand that the proposal comes following continued audience and revenue losses for Valleys Radio as a direct consequence of a move of listeners onto stations able to transmit on FM; this followed a period of strong audience growth and profitability. There is also the need to move from two tired buildings to a more suitable facility.

Since reaching its peak in 2004 when Valleys Radio listeners were tuning in for 1,334,000 hours a week this figure has dropped to just 540,000 hours a week in 2008. At the same time they have recorded financial loses each year since 2006.

The business plan suggests that re-location and a switch from AM to FM would help take Valleys Radio back to a profitable position in the medium term. The switch from AM to FM will mean clearer stereo output for listeners and provide job security and new opportunities for training and development.

I understand that the co-location project will not mean a reduction in the number of journalists and that the work force will be kept fully informed throughout the whole process.

I have also asked those in charge of the project to keep me up to date with their plans.

I hope that Ofcom will give sympathetic consideration to this matter.
