Re: Valleys Radio co-location proposals

I am writing on behalf of myself and my colleague Christopher Franks AM regarding to co-location proposals of Valley Radio, Swansea Sound and The Wave into one UTV South Wales headquarters.

As part of the proposals, an additional £80,000 per annum will be invested to take Valleys Radio to FM transmission.

The transition to FM for Valleys Radio will ensure a steady growth in regular audience figures and will also increase revenue.

We are fully supportive of the proposals to co-locate Valleys Radio, Swansea Sound and The Wave in a single South Wales Headquarters such as the one being proposed at Swansea Gate Business Park and the transfer of Valleys Radio to an FM transmission and would urge OFCOM to support this measure also.
