I have read the PSB review document with interest and while I am interested in many parts of it, it is in my role as a Glasgow based independent producer that I am writing.

It is crucial that PSB reflects the whole of the UK to the whole of the UK and it is essential that it is not just left to the BBC. The BBC is at its most effective when it has Channel 4 competing with it for the best programme ideas and production talent. If you take one of them out network production in the Nations and Regions will wither. It is for this reason that I feel that Option 3 would be the best way to move forward if the standards that we are used to are to be maintained.

Channel 4 have been fantastically supportive to Nations and Regions independents. By following Option 3 it will help the BBC deliver their targets for network programming from outside the M25 and it is my opinion this can only be achieved by support from both broadcasters.
