I am writing to express my opposition to the auction of part of the 10GHz spectrum. Part of the spectrum is currently allocated for international amateur satellite use. Clearly, radio amateurs in the UK may be unable to use this spectrum if a primary user has it allocated on the standard basis for a primary user. I am also dismayed that the lax out-of-band emission requirements may cause interference to other amateur radio allocations in adjacent blocks of spectrum.

Can I request that OFCOM reconsiders its policy on spectrum sell-offs, or at least puts in place some safeguards for Amateur Radio users?
