

BROADCASTING ACT 1996 (AS AMENDED BY THE COMMUNICATIONS ACT 2003 AND MODIFIED BY THE TELEVISION MULTIPLEX SERVICES (RENEWAL OF MULTIPLEX LICENCES) ORDER 2021)

NOTICE OF RENEWAL DATED 26 MAY 2022

IN RESPECT OF LICENCE GRANTED TO DIGITAL 3 AND 4 LIMITED ("THE LICENSEE") TO PROVIDE A MULTIPLEX SERVICE UNDER PART I OF THE BROADCASTING ACT 1996 (AS AMENDED AND MODIFIED) DATED 19 DECEMBER 1997, RENEWED 3 JUNE 2009, AND VARIED BY VARIATIONS NUMBERS 1-33 ("THE LICENCE").

WHEREAS:

- A The Licensee has applied by letter to the Office of Communications ('Ofcom') dated 11 November 2021 for the renewal of the Licence from 19 December 2022 (the Renewal Date) under section 16 of the Broadcasting Act 1996 (as amended and modified);
- B Ofcom has decided to grant such application for renewal;
- C Ofcom has notified the Licensee of new Conditions 14(2)-(5) of the Licence securing that the holder of the Licence is a body corporate controlled by one relevant public service broadcaster, or two or more relevant public service broadcasters taken together, of new Condition 23(6) of the Licence under which Ofcom may revoke the Licence where the nature or characteristics of the body or bodies corporate controlling the Licensee change in a manner contrary to Condition 14(2), of new Condition 23(7) which allows Ofcom, with the consent of the Secretary of State, to revoke the Licence for reasons related to the management of the radio spectrum, of the deletion of Condition 10, and of changes to certain Definitions;
- D The Licensee has notified Ofcom in writing that it consents to the Licence being renewed on these terms, as set out in the Licence attached to this Notice.

Ofcom hereby gives the Licensee notice that the Licence shall be renewed with effect from 19 December 2022 and, subject to the Conditions set out in the Schedule and the Annex to the Licence, the Licence so renewed shall continue until 31 December 2034.

This Notice of Renewal shall be construed as if it formed part of the Licence and shall be governed by English law.
