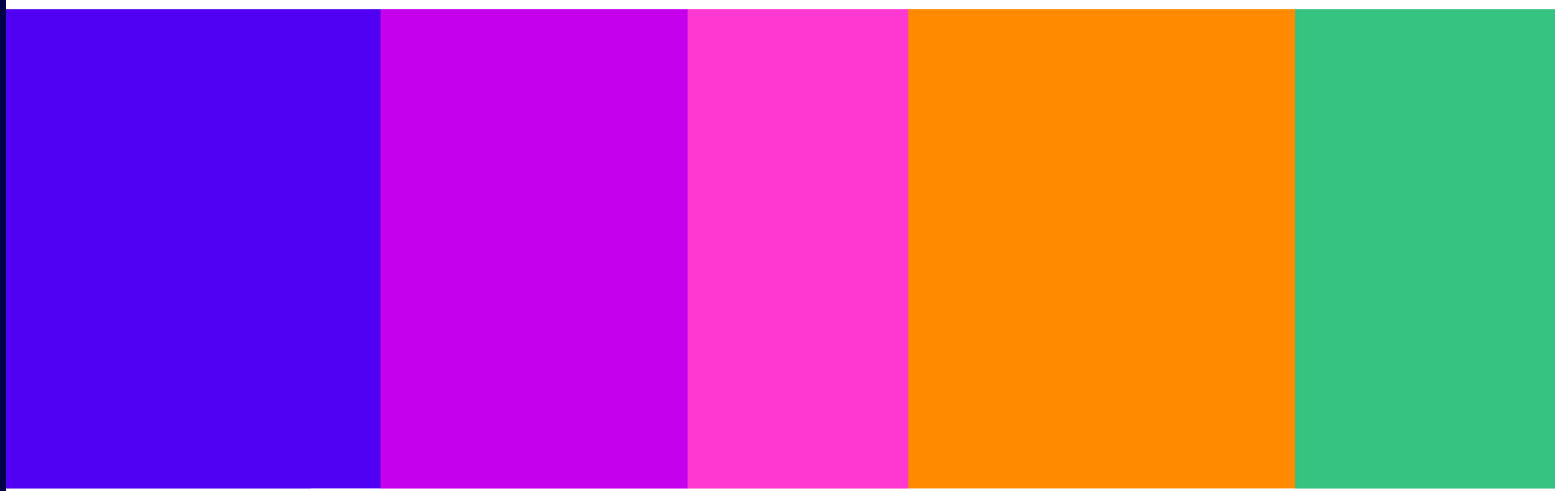


Survey: Barriers to Proving Age on Adult Sites – 2024

Technical Report

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Introduction

Preface

The Barriers to Proving Age on Adult Sites survey was undertaken by YouGov on behalf of Ofcom. This report refers to the project completed as Wave 2 in December 2024 with a new sample, as a follow-on from Wave 1 which took place in August/September 2023.

The core objective of this study was to understand and expand on knowledge in the following topic areas:

- How users access pornographic content online
- Users' experiences of 'proving' their age to access pornographic content online
- Reasons why some users have never proved their age to access pornographic content online
- Current sentiment on age verification and age estimation on pornographic websites or services as well as independent third-party companies
- Factors that influence the likelihood of completing an age check to access pornographic content online

Summary of approach

YouGov is a professional research and consulting organisation, focused on collecting high quality, in-depth data for market research and has extensive experience of youth, the television and radio broadcasting sectors as well as on-demand services policy research.

This research was conducted with a sample of respondents aged 16+ who self-reported to have previously accessed pornographic content online and plan on accessing again in the future.

All research was carried out online, with respondents recruited from YouGov's online panel, containing around 3,113,610¹ panellists from all over the UK.

For Wave 1 (2023) of the study, a total of 5,242 interviews were conducted. Fieldwork was conducted between 18th August – 14th September 2023. In Wave 2, a total of 5,543 interviews were conducted, with fieldwork taking place between 12th – 29th December 2024.

Significance testing and data redaction

Data tables were run using Quantipy. Significance testing (via t-tests) has been applied at 95% for the purposes of analysis within the individual waves, and at 99% between Wave 1 and Wave 2.

All base sizes below 10 have been redacted/removed from the data tables completely. Base sizes between 10-49 are marked with an * to indicate a low base.

Sampling

In Wave 2, YouGov interviewed a sample of 5,543 UK respondents aged 16+ who self-reported to have previously accessed pornographic content online and plan on accessing again in future. The reason for selecting this sample is to understand actual users' attitudes towards proving their age on adult sites (as opposed to internet users in general).

Fieldwork was carried out between 12th – 29th December 2024.

The sample quota was based on the demographic profile of general X-rated adult website/app UK visitors aged 15+ in October 2024, as reported by Ipsos Iris. The data has not been weighted, as the sample naturally aligned with the demographic profile, particularly the skew towards men, as observed in the Ipsos Iris data.

Further details on the sample design and research methodology are outlined below.

Sample design

The sample of users was provided by YouGov's proprietary online panel. Only those who had accessed pornographic content previously and plan to do so in future was accepted to take part, using the following screener within the survey:

Q3. Now thinking about the different websites or services you have used in the past over the internet, have you ever tried to access pornographic content online?

- **Yes, and I plan on accessing pornographic content online in future**
- **Yes, but I do not plan on accessing pornographic content online in future [SCREEN OUT]**
- **No [SCREEN OUT]**
- **Don't know [SCREEN OUT]**
- **Prefer not to say [SCREEN OUT]**

Further screen-outs were applied later in the survey:

Q4 (Age Verification): Respondents who could not confirm whether they had proven their age ("Don't know" or "Prefer not to say") were screened out to maintain data reliability.

Q5 (Reasons for Not Proving Age): Respondents who stated they had never attempted to access pornographic content online were screened out, as their responses were not relevant to the question.

The full question wording is available at the end of the report with the questionnaire.

Most demographic information (age, gender, social grade, ethnicity, household income, working status, region) was information declared and collected by YouGov from its panellists as part of the initial signing up process. This information is updated regularly by panellists (every 6 months).

YouGov carried out the following standard checks during and post-fieldwork:

- A manual check post-fieldwork to remove anyone who responded in an unreasonable or suspicious way.
- Open end checks to ensure respondents answered thoughtfully and were not spamming answers or bots.
- Ongoing panel quality monitoring and removal of respondents identified as straight-liners from the YouGov Panel.

Quotas

Interview quotas were established to ensure the final sample included approximately 150 responses per age group for analysis. The targeted age groups included were 16-17, 18-24, 25-34, 35-44, 45-54, 55-64, 65-74, and 75+. However, due to the lower feasibility of reaching participants aged 16-17, the final sample size for this group was 102 respondents.

Between Wave 1 (2023) and Wave 2 (2024), there were slight adjustments to the quotas, primarily aimed at increasing the proportion of male respondents. The table below outlines these changes:

The sample remains broadly comparable between Wave 1 (2023) and Wave 2 (2024), despite the slight adjustments to quotas. While the male sample size increased marginally from 73% to 74%, plus minor shifts in age group distributions, these changes do not significantly impact the overall comparability of the data. The adjustments were carefully managed to ensure that the integrity of longitudinal comparisons is maintained, allowing for robust analysis of trends over time.

Fieldwork

All interviews in Wave 2 were conducted online between 12th – 29th December 2024.

Due to the sensitive nature of the research topic (e.g. questions related to accessing pornographic content), respondents were forewarned and asked to give their consent to participate, in line with MRS guidelines. Questions (Q21-Q26) related to sentiment towards age verification and age estimation on pornographic websites/independent third parties that were asked as part of the research were suppressed for respondents under 18. Furthermore, a question relating to VPN usage to access pornographic content was amended for respondents aged 16-17, so that the survey did not inadvertently promote usage of VPN to access pornographic content to under-age respondents.

To test consumer understanding, we included self-declaration methods such as “enter my date of birth” and “tick a box or click a button which asks whether I am 18+” when respondents were asked what methods they used to prove their age to access pornographic content. However, Ofcom do not consider self-declaration as a form of age assurance therefore self-declaration would not be considered as a method for proving age under the Online Safety Act.

Definitions of **age verification** and **age estimation** shown to respondents in the research:

Age verification is determining whether someone is aged 18 or above by verifying their exact age.

Examples of age verification methods include verifying someone’s:

- Credit card details
- Online banking details
- Identity documents (e.g. passport, driving licence, ID card, birth certificate or similar)

It does not include age check methods such as ticking a box to confirm someone is 18+ or entering a date of birth.

Age estimation is determining whether someone is aged 18 or above by estimating their age or age range. Examples include someone uploading or scanning their face, or speaking with their voice to get an estimated age.

Demographic breakdown

The following table shows the demographic breakdown of the sample in Wave 2, after screen outs and data cleaning:
